Please be advised that clubs are non-refundable.

Please book and make payment on ARBOR. Clubs will be released at 4pm on Wednesday 22nd July and close at 08:00am on Wednesday 19th August. We will not take bookings after this date.

If you wish to pay by **Childcare Vouchers**, please put the club in your basket and let us know which clubs you have booked via email.

If you are entitled to **Pupil Premium Support** please also put club in you basket, then follow this link <https://www.prioryschool.co.uk/pupil-premium> to request support, when this has been authorised we will let you know.

Please can you inform us before booking if your child has any specific needs (i.e. has EHCP or SEN needs), this is important to ensure that the correct supervision is in place.

All Sports clubs require P.E. kit and trainers; otherwise, they will not be able to participate.

If your child is taking a KS2 football club shin pads are essential and football boots (no metal studs) are highly recommended, KS1 will just need PE Kit and trainers.

Some clubs have very limited numbers and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. If your payment is accepted on ARBOR, this is confirmation that your child has a place on the club requested. We also keep a waiting list and if a space becomes available, the next person on the list will be contacted.

Please note in the case of heavy rainfall, outdoor clubs will be held indoors.

Children will need to be collected promptly at 4.15pm. If you are continuously late, this may affect your child being able to attend future clubs.

If you are driving, for the safety of the children, please use the Visitors' Car Park and walk round; do not use the Staff carpark when collecting your child(ren).
