

Primary Languages at Priory School

At Priory School pupils in KS2, from Y3 –Y6, study French as their foreign language taught by a specialist teacher. Pupils have one lesson a week throughout the year. Pupils learn through listening, speaking, reading and writing, using songs, stories and film clips of native speakers.

Y5	L'Évacuation Reading and understanding a longer story in French about an evacuee, which uses a range of both familiar and new vocabulary. Pupils learn how to use a bilingual dictionary and are introduced to the position of adjectives in a noun phrase in French, as well as beginning to look at how some regular verbs are conjugated/ changed.		Les Planètes Describing the planets in French, using a range of adjectives and noticing both the position and agreement of adjectives in French.	Le Facteur Spatiale Reading a story about a Space Postman. The story provides the opportunity for learning more about how regular verbs change in French.	En Ville Pupils learn the names in French of a range of places in town and follow sets of directions to find places on a map.	
Y6	Le Grand Monstre Vert Reading a humorous story leads to pupils writing their own description of a monster again focusing on the agreement of adjectives.	Harry Potter Building on the previous topic, pupils learn the words for clothes in French and describe a character from Harry Potter.	L'École Pupils learn the names of school subjects in French and how to express likes and dislikes and how to talk about a timetable in French, saying what subjects they have at different times.		Londres Pupils learn how to express the capitals of different countries and to write what famous landmarks can be found in London.
