Orchard News

In English, the children have been reading their story 'Drop: An Adventure through the Water Cycle' (Story can be found here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=4TB-34sIKdc), they have been recapping the sequence of the water cycle. The children have been sequencing the water cycle using sentences and visuals; to support the learning of the key vocabulary of the water cycle.



In Maths, the children have been exploring time, the use of practical clocks to help support their learning of telling the time to the hour and half hour. They have also been exploring 2D and 3D shapes and finding these shapes around the school environment.





In Science, the children have started to look at what a plant depends on to grow from a seed. As well as, looking at common plants we would find walking around; such as daisies, daffodils, roses and dandelions. We have been trying to spot them around the school field when we walk the Priory Mile.



In Art, the children have been continuing their exploration of mixing colours to create a range of dark and light colours. They have then used these colours to paint a mountainous scene. On the subject of art, Cherry class want to share an amazing piece of artwork drawn by Ethan; the piece is of Peppa Pig and her family


