Our Learning

English

This week in class, we have been exploring the poem 'Tell me a dragon'. We created our own dragon eggs and used shape coding to write descriptive sentences about the different dragons.

Maths

This week, we have been comparing numbers and objects using the comparison symbols $<$, $>$ and $=$. We have also been using the vocabulary – more, less, greater, fewer and equal. After half term, we will be ordering numbers and objects.
