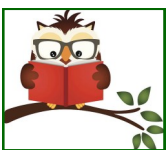

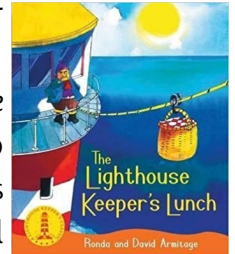
Our Learning

English

This week in class, we have continued to explore our story – The lighthouse keeper's lunch.

We started the week by looking at what the characters are doing. We matched vocabulary to story pictures and wrote 'what doing' sentences using shape coding structures. We also sequenced the everts and answered comprehension questions about the story.

Next week, we will begin our final story of this year – The lighthouse keeper's cat.

This week, we have been looking at numbers to 30. We have looked at different number representations, counted forwards and backwards and started to identify tens and one. Next week, we will look at one more, one less and comparing groups of objects.

Miss Hall's maths.

This week, Miss Hall's maths group have continued to explore shapes. They completed 3-D shape patterns and learnt about a vertical line of symmetry in 2-D shapes. Next week, they will begin their unit on multiplication. .
