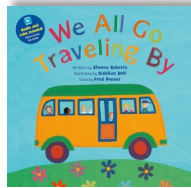

Our Learning

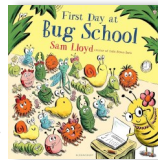
It's been a busy week for Woodlands!

Woodlands Badgers:

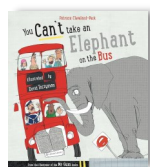


This week we started a new book and we love it! It's called We All Go Travelling By, and we've been singing the songs, making puzzles and doing good sharing as we play with the toys together.

Woodlands Owls:

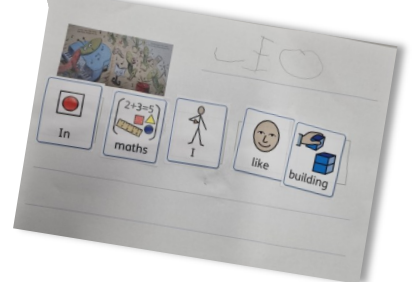
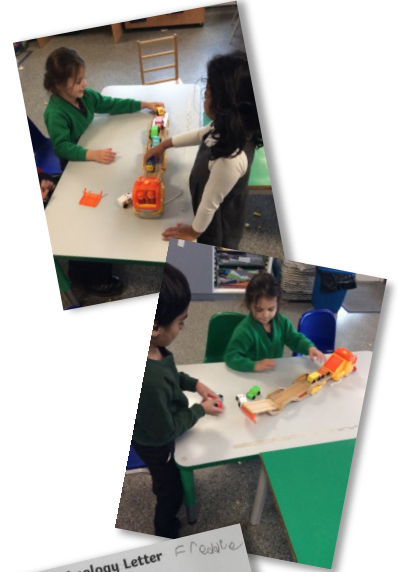


In our Early years group we are reading First Day At Bug School. We talked about our favourite lessons, and have written what we like best about them.
