


## Peek at the Week Year 1 – 19th April 2024

## Our Learning

This week: In maths, we have been learning about length and height. We measured items around the classroom using objects, including cubes.

In English, we begun reading You Can't Take an Elephant on the Bus. We wrote down reasons why you can't take an elephant on the bus using the conjunction 'because'.

In Geography, the children started looking at transport and transport hubs in the local area.

**Next week** :In maths, we will be looking at mass and volume. We will start comparing and measuring mass.

In English, we will continue to read *You Can't*Take an Elephant on the Bus and will be choosing animals to go on different types of transport.

In Geography, the children will be using junk modelling to create their own transport hubs.
