In English, the children created and described their own flavour of jelly bean for the jelly beanstalk.

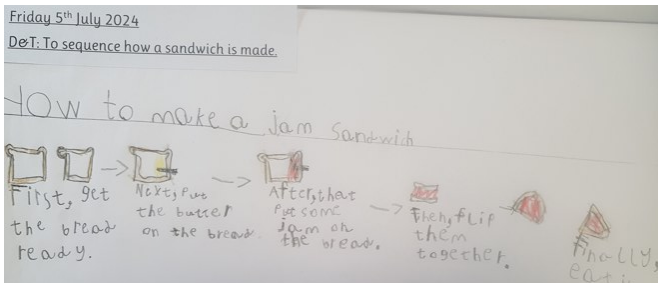
In Design and Technology, the children have begun learning about how we make sandwiches and tasted their own sandwich fillings.
