Our Learning

This week, the children have been continuing writing their letters and then they have been writing it out on pretty paper and sending it to Mrs Foster in an envelope. In Maths, the children have been exploring multiplication and discovering how a repeated addition number sentence can be written as a multiplication number sentence for example $2 + 2 + 2$ is the same as 3×2 .

After the holidays, the children will be continuing to learn about multiplication. The children will be writing a number sentence such as 3×2 and then drawing what it represents. It would be great if the children can continue to practise counting in 2, 5 and 10. If you google: counting by 2, you will get some good songs that will help your child learn more easily.

Our new topic is going to be Windsor Castle and the children will be going for a visit to the Castle on the 20th March. In preparation for the trip, we will be looking at landmarks in the local area and in London. Then we will begin looking at our new book, The Queen's Hat.
