Our Learning

This week, in English, the children have been looking at the features and structure of a persuasive letter. We have also been focusing on reading a text and answering inferential questions about it.

In Science, we have been exploring the environment in our school and investigating why animals and insects live there. We also have been growing beans hydroponically.

In maths, we have been practising counting

different amounts of money and making an amount of money using different combinations of coins.
