Our Learning

This week, in Maths we have been looking at grouping and dividing by 2. This is another activity that you could practise at home with your child. For example, $15 \div 5 = 3$. You would split the counters into groups of 5 then count how many groups you have.

In English, we have been learning about the main character in our new story and we have written a character description. Then we predicted what we think will happen next in the story,

In Geography the children have been learning about the four different countries in The United Kingdom.

Next week, in Maths the children are moving on to statistics. We are going to be making tally charts and learning how shapes represent different amounts in pictograms.

If your children can continue to practise their 2, 5 and 10 times table then this will really help.

In English, we will be using drama techniques to explore how the characters in our story are feeling. We will build up to writing a diary entry about this from their point of view.

In Science, we will be celebrating Science week and the theme for this year is Growth. During the week we will be creating seed bombs and lentil men by planting seeds in cups. We will also be using different equipment around the school to create our own exercises to keep fit.
