Our Learning

This week, the children have been working hard in Maths subtracting a one digit number and tens from a bigger number. Next week, we are going to be subtracting a two digit number from a two digit number on a number line. Please continue to practise number bonds to 20 with your children as we are doing a big focus on this, this half term.

In English this week, the children have been thinking about 'litter' and why it is bad. The children wrote fantastic speeches persuading their audience that you should not litter and why it is bad for animals.

In Science, the children have been learning about the lifecycle of a plant and we have been doing an experiment to see how well seeds grow in different environments for example with no water and no sunlight. We can't wait to see how they turn out!
