Our Learning

This week in maths we have been practising counting forwards and backwards in tens. We have been looking at missing numbers on number lines when the interval is ten and re-capping flexibility partitioning numbers.

This week, we have continued writing our own version of 'Vlad and the Great Fire of London.' The children have really enjoyed creating their own character and using all their knowledge of the event in 1666 to help create their narrative. We have discussed using adjectives to make our writing more interesting

In Science, we have been looking at materials and their properties. The children have had the opportunity to look at a range of objects and discuss the materials and their properties.

Next week, in Maths, children will be estimating numbers on a number line. In English, we will be looking at the poem 'The Woolly Saucepan.'
