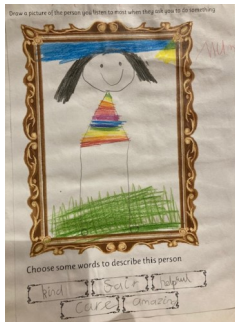

Our Learning

This week, in Maths the children have worked really hard on their assessment test papers.

In English, the children were continuing to plan and write their own stories. We will also spent time editing our work, focusing on spelling, capital letters and other punctuation.



In RE, the children were learning to understand how celebrating Passover helps Jews show God that they value their special relationship with Him. The children did some lovely work about who they respect and why as part of these lessons.

After half term, in Maths the children are going to be continuing to work on sharing. If you have any time at home, it would be really useful if your child could practise sharing items out into groups for example 20 pieces of pasta into 3 groups. It is better not to use large quantities as your child may become confused about how many pieces of pasta they have.

In English, we will be starting to explore our new text: The Secret Sky Garden by Linda Sarah. Two of the main themes in this story are friendship and littering. If possible, please talk to your children about the problem of littering near your home or on your journey to school and the negative impact it has on wildlife and the local community.
