### Our Learning

**This week**, in Maths we have been looking at 2D shapes, it would be really good if you could look for different 2D shapes around the home. Then you can talk about how many sides and vertices your shape has. In English, we were learning about the features of a persuasive letter and then planned and wrote a letter to Mrs Foster suggesting ways that we could improve our school and local area through planting.

**For Creativity Week**, we were creating exciting displays around our school. One of our displays will represent the flags of the four nations found in the UK. On the other display, we will be celebrating our similarities and differences.

**Next week**, in Maths, the children are going to be learning about 3D shapes and how many faces there are on each shape. We are also going to be doing some assessment papers to see how we are getting on with our Maths. In English, we will be completing written reading comprehensions using some of the key skills we have been practising recently such as scanning for key words and using evidence in the text to answer the questions.

In Geography, we will be looking at the three remaining nations of the United Kingdom; Wales, Northern Ireland and England.
