Hawking's learning gallery will be this Wednesday 4th May after school.

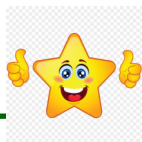

Our Learning

This week, in Maths we have been looking at fractions in more detail. We have been focusing on recognising halves and thirds then we have been looking at three quarters. It would be great if the children can continue to practise their 2,5 and 10 times table. Also, if they can go over their number bonds to 20 this will also help. In English, we have started to explore our new text 'The Snail and the Whale'. We have debated whether we think the snail should stay on the rock or go travelling around the world with the whale. We have then written a short letter to the snail, telling her what to do and why.

Next week, in Maths we are going to be working on worded problems using division, multiplication, addition and subtraction. Also, we are going to be learning to tell them time, it would be really useful if the children could be practising telling the time at home. In English, we will be exploring some of the different places around the world that the snail and whale visit together in our story. We will use our senses to think about what they will hear, see and feel in these places. We will then be writing diary entries in role as the snail about our journey.

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
