Our Learning

This week the children have been getting stuck into their maths work. We have been learning all about partitioning using a part whole number. This is something that you can practise at the home, ask your child- how many tens are in the number? How do we write it? How many ones are in the number?

It is also really important for your child to practise writing the numbers 1-20 at home and please ensure that the numbers are the right way round especially 9, 7, 3 and 6.

In English this week, we have continued to write about The Great Fire of London. The children have been learning about Samuel Pepys and his diary.

Next week, we are going to be moving on to looking at another story set in 1666, 'Vlad and The Great Fire of London.'

In maths, we are going to be looking at numbers to 100 and counting in 10s on a number line.

A gentle reminder, please can you ensure that your child's clothes are all labelled with their name.
