Our Learning

This week, in maths we have been continuing to learn about the greater and less than symbol. Next week, we are going to be moving on to counting in 2,5 and 10 which would be a really useful skill to practise with your child at home. Then we are going to be moving on to adding a two digit number and one digit number. You can also work on this at home with your child. Get them to put the bigger number in their head and then count on using their fingers to add the one digit number.

In English next week, we are going to be looking at our text for this half term, Anna Hibiscus. The children will be thinking about what it is like to have a big, extended family.

In Geography, we are going to be looking at the physical and human features of Naro Maru in Kenya. If anyone has ever been to Kenya and has any items or experiences that we could share with the children to help their understanding of how Kenya is different to England that would be amazing.
