Our Learning

This week, in Maths the children have been continuing to work on sharing. If you have any time at home, it would be really useful if your child could practise sharing items out into groups for example 20 pieces of pasta into 3 groups. It is better not to use large quantities as your child may become confused about how many pieces of pasta they have.

In English, this week we have been learning all about 'Litter'. The children were discussing why it is important that people don't litter and they wrote a speech explaining their reasons.

In our afternoon lessons this week, we have enjoyed immersing ourselves in the story of 'Alice in Wonderland'. The children have summarised the story and created their own puppets to act it out.



Next week, in Maths we are going to be looking at grouping and dividing by 2. This is another activity that you could practise at home with your child. For example, $15 \div 5 =$. You would split the counters into groups of 5 then count how many groups you have.

In English, we are going to be learning about the main character in our new story and we are going to be writing a character description. Then we are going to be predicting what we think will happen next in the story.

In Geography the children are going to be learning about the four different countries in The United Kingdom.
