Our Learning

This week in maths we have been looking at how to spell numbers in words for example twenty. This is something that you can continue to practise at home. We have also been looking at flexibly partitioning numbers for example 57 can be partitioned into 50 and 7 but it can also be partitioned into 27 and 30.

This week, the children have been reading the story 'Vlad and The Great Fire of London' and from that, the children are going to be reading their own version of the story. This is a great opportunity for the children to include all the information that they have learned about The Great Fire of London.

In maths, the children will be continuing to learn about number lines and where to place 1s and 10s. Then we will be going on to look at blank number lines and placing numbers in the right place.

Next week, the children will be learning about 'Everyday Materials' in science and the properties of different materials.
