Our Learning

This week, in English we have been learning about the Commonwealth Games which links in with our Sports Week. We have also been starting to think about the transition to Year 3. In maths this week, we have been learning about positional language (left, right, forwards, backwards, above, below) through a mixture of practical and written activities. In maths, we have completed lots of practical activities to consolidate our knowledge on positional language.

Next week, in English the children are going to be recapping the past and present tense. Also, we will be looking at stories about the seaside. In maths we will be recapping some key skills and applying them to complete challenges based on place value, addition and subtraction. **This week** in History we have compared the Victorian seaside to that of the 1950's and now.
