Our Learning

English

This week the children have planned their own story called 'The Happy Pharaoh' which they will start to write next week. They enjoyed discussing what parts of the original story they could change and how they could use their historical knowledge of Ancient Egypt. In our story plans, the focus has been on which success criteria the children will use in their own narrative.

Maths

This week the children have developed their understanding of multiplication by focusing on scaling to compare lengths or amounts. They have also gained experience of solving correspondence problems by systematically listing all the combinations resulting from combining two groups of objects. Next week the children will begin a new unit about length and perimeter.



Art

The children have used textured paper to experiment with a variety of collage techniques, including layering. As well as exploring warm and cool colours, they have begun to use tone to express feelings and to create mood. They are becoming more confident at using art vocabulary to explain their ideas.
