Year 3 and 4 badminton festival

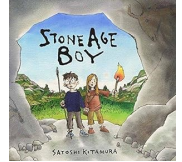
Congratulations to the seven year 3 children who represented the school at a badminton festival on Tuesday. They did extremely well and were placed 4th overall. We are so proud of all these children.



Our Learning

English

In English this week we have continued to read our text 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura. The children have written impressive and outstanding sentences using language features that include onomatopoeia, conjunctions, verbs, phrases, time adverbials, similes and repetition. Next week, we will begin planning and writing our version of the Stone-Age boy.



Maths

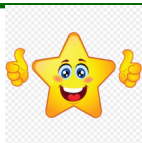
This week, the children started spotting patterns when adding tens, hundreds and ones. Also, they have begun adding across tens, hundred and ones. We have started subtracting ones across a hundred. Next week, we will continue subtracting across a 100 and we will make connections between adding and subtracting 100s.

History

We have done some amazing work drawing the three different types of stone age houses (Old- Palaeolithic, Middle-Mesolithic and New-Neolithic). The children have written the materials used to build these houses. We have discussed the various tools used in the stone age such as flint awl, flint axe, flint scrapper, nit comb . We have discussed farming, the types of clothes they wore and used this knowledge to write a diary entry as a stone age girl or boy.
