Our Learning

English

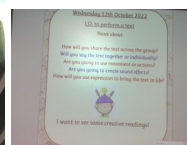
This week we created a story map to show the main events in our story 'Pebble in my Pocket' and we annotated them with key words. We also performed parts of the story and brought them to life using actions, movements and expression. Next week we will be researching how sedimentary rocks are formed.

Maths

This week, the children learnt adding, subtracting and making connections with 1s, 10s and 100s. They had a recap lesson on the different words they could use instead of saying subtraction. They used partitioning and number lines to subtract two and three digit numbers.

RE

This week we started our RE lessons about the Hindu festival of Diwali. We learnt this festival is about good over evil and discussed the importance of light. The children looked at religious artefacts and some children shared their knowledge of Diwali. We then looked at the lyrics of a Diwali song and why the singer chose the words in the song.
