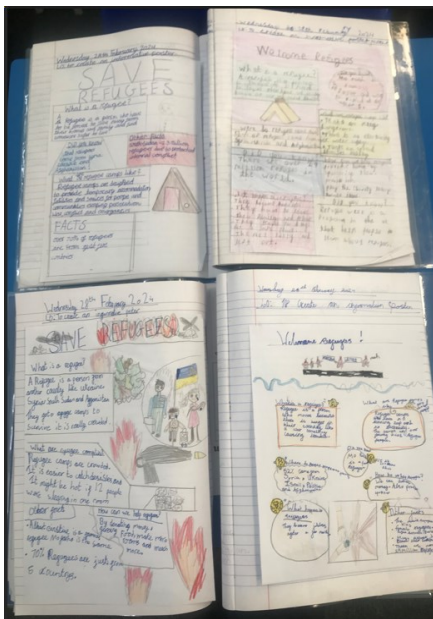

Our Learning

This week, in DT, we began to gather ideas to design a money box container, fit for purpose. We drew and designed our money containers and planned our steps to make a successful money container.

In maths, we continued to learn how to calculate the perimeter of rectilinear shapes such as polygons. We also learnt how to calculate missing lengths.

In English, we continued reading *The Boy at the Back of the Class*. We researched refugees, using the Chromebooks, and created information pages on what we found.

Next week, in DT, we will use our plans to create and decorate our money containers using textiles.

In maths, we will start a new topic on Fractions. We will understand how a whole is made up of fractions and begin to explore mixed numbers.

In English, we will be delving deeper into refugeeism by exploring poetry by Amineh Abou Kerech and by researching the war in Syria and how this led to the displacement of its citizens.
