### Our Learning

**This week**, we've settled into our new classes and have had a full week of fun lessons all about the Romans! We kick-started our week with some collage-making in art lessons, building on skills to create our very own Roman mosaic.

**In maths**, we recapped and expanded our knowledge of place value and applied this in our maths work, developing our use of sentence stems and problem-solving skills. We also took our baseline times-tables quiz!

**In English**, we began our unit on *The Roman Diary of Illiona*, which follows the story of a young female slave living in Ancient Rome. We put ourselves in the shoes of Roman gladiators and are now beginning to understand the excitement (and brutality) of the Roman games!

**Next week**, in history, we will begin to learn more about what life was like in Britain when the Romans invaded.

**In maths**, we will continue building on our knowledge of place value and number– learning how to represent and partition numbers on a number line up to 10,000.

**In English**, we will focus on writing effective sentences for our diary entry. We will look at the features of diaries and build a bank of topic vocabulary that we can use across the topic.
