This week, in DT, we used our plans to create and decorate our money containers using textiles.

In geography, we began our new topic Europe, we will focus on European countries, capitals, topography and politics including demographics and migration.

In maths, we started a new topic on Fractions. We understood how a whole is made up of fractions and began to explore mixed numbers

In English, we delved deeper into refugeeism by exploring poetry by Amineh Abou Kerech and by researching the war in Syria and how this led to the displacement of its citizens.
